Reminder – Some of the vouchers are direct-to-lift tickets. Do not carry extra vouchers/tickets with you while you ski, as they will be activated by the scanner whether they are clipped to your jacket or carried in a pocket. Once scanned, they are only good for that day and thereby considered used and void. Also, it is important to keep the tab that is attached in the bottom of some of the vouchers/tickets in case you lose your lift ticket while skiing. Be sure to read the CSC Bulk Ticket Policy that Colleen Mannion attaches to your order.

# SKI SWAP 2014: Friday Nov. 28<sup>th</sup> (Black Friday), Saturday Nov. 29<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, Nov. 30<sup>th</sup> and the next Saturday Dec. 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday Dec. 7<sup>th</sup>

Come volunteer to help your club at the ski swap. This is our only fundraiser to subsidize our lodge, various social events and our On Snow Day this year at Catamount. Many hands make the work light. We need help to set up (8:30 am to 10 am) and break down (5 pm to 5:39 pm) and during the swap 10 am to 5 pm to take in the sale items and enter it in the computer, tend to the cash register to record sales made and be a salesperson to assist the customers to find the items that best suit their needs at discount rates. We suggest 5 hour shifts 8:30 am-1:30 pm or 1 pm-6 pm

We provide coffee, hot chocolate and donuts in the morning and lunch to all volunteers. All volunteers who put in 5 or more hours get a 15% discount on non-sale items at the Ski Haus in New Milford until March 1st 2015 and may enter their swap items for free. If you put in 18 hours you get two adult lodge vouchers (The Maples) and If you put in greater than 38 hours you receive 4 adult lodge vouchers.

The Swap enables our club to give back to the community discounts on decent and recent ski and snowboard equipment to purchase and allows the community to turn in their equipment and clothing for \$2.00 an item and place their equipment and clothing in our swap. If it sells they get 80% of the sale. If the item doesn't sell it must be picked up by 4 pm on Sunday, Dec. 7<sup>th</sup>, or it becomes the property of Danbury ski club. Be sure to let sellers know that they must have their claim check to get their item back.

Be sure to tell your friends and family about the swap. The Ski Haus will put in merchandise to the Swap also.

This year we will not be accepting cross country skis and boots, rear entry boots, helmets and straight skis,

All equipment should be in good condition prior to being accepted into the swap.

**FYI** - Our presentation will spend its second month (November) in the display case that is located on the lower floor, opposite the Farioly Program Room, Danbury Library on West Street. If you get a chance, stop by and check it out. A lot of history and present-day info is presented there. Our first trophy (Randall's) was awarded in 1958 and it's still going annually to the most outstanding member. It's a honey to behold.

The **Danbury Ski Club lodge, THE MAPLES**, on RT. 100 in Weston, VT will open for the season **Friday, December 5th**. It is just a short drive from all the central Vermont ski areas. You are invited to come up for the weekend - for free – and help get the lodge set up. Or not, if you'd rather just go up to use the lodge, paying the regular rate. It sleeps up to 37 people in 5 bedrooms and "The Loft." Amenities include a full kitchen with 2 stoves and 3 refrigerators, dining room and a comfortable living room to stretch out in to relive the day's events in front of a fireplace, or enjoy the internet access. Cell phone reception is improved this year.

Bring your own sheets and pillowcases or sleeping bag and towel. Rates for the coming season are \$27 per night for DSC members and \$16 per night for member children 17 and younger. Guests of members are \$5 more per night.

This year we will again offer early-bird lodge vouchers. Five adult or five children vouchers may be purchased for the price of four at club business meetings (11/6 and 12/4). Last day for this offer will be at the club's Holiday Party (12/18).
