
Over 100 attended our Christmas party on Thursday, December 17th. Kudos to Janice Cohen for organizing a wonderful evening!

BUS:

The bus leaves from the Exit 2 Park and Ride off I84 at 7:00am sharp. Please be there by <u>6:45am</u> at the latest. We will arrive at the mountain at 8:30am. The bus will leave Catamount at ~9:30pm, returning to the Park and Ride at 11pm.

Bus availability is based on when payment is received. A second bus will not be reserved unless we can almost fill it, so sign up and pay ASAP. The sooner we know we need a second bus, the easier it will be to reserve one.

Additional Helpful Hints for Club Members who purchased OKEMO Vouchers

- Record the number on the front of each card purchased in case they are destroyed or lost. Okemo Group Sales can deactivate a card and issue a replacement if they have the card number(s).

- Only carry one card at a time on your person when you are on the mountain.

- Record the number of the card you are carrying on any given day in case you lose it during the day.

Resort Services can deactivate the card and issue a new card if you can provide the card number.

- Do not punch a hole in the card.

- Do not put the card next to your cell phone or foil such as gum wrappers

March 31 → April 3, 2016

We are returning to Jay Peak for their annual <u>Beach Party Weekend</u>, where the <u>average annual snowfall is 30 FEET</u>. So get ready for the BEST spring skiing in the East. This trip includes 3 days skiing, 3 nights lodging (Thursday/Friday/ Saturday), coach bus transportation, happy hour/pizza party, Jay's wild Beach Party Saturday evening and a "bag lunch" for the bus ride home. There is also an option for the huge water park! Check out <u>www.jaypeakresort.com</u>

LODGING OPTIONS:

- <u>Cottages:</u> All 8 cottages reserved have two bedrooms (all split king beds), a living room, kitchen, and are located within walking distance of the Stateside Hotel and the slopes, with shuttle buses every few minutes. Cottages are numbers 4778 – 4785 (you can locate them on the site map).
- Stateside Hotel: 2 Queens, or 1 King & a sleeper sofa per room. 7 rooms reserved by Hamden. Double occupancy (per bedroom) is assumed.
- 3. We'll try to accommodate everyone's rooming preferences.

BUS:

We'll leave Danbury from the commuter lot on Federal Road, across from Planet Fitness at 1:15pm (be there by 1:00pm, we will have a lot to load), with pickups at Exit 17 (Middlebury) at 1:35pm and off I91 at exit 35 (Windsor) at 2:15pm. The bus MUST have at least 40 people for this trip to work. The trip will take 6 hours with these stops. Bring your dinner; the bus will not stop until we get to Jay Peak, except possibly a grocery store upon arrival. We'll leave Jay at 4:15pm on Sunday and will not stop for dinner. You will be able to buy something for the road before we leave. Weather could impact these plans, so be prepared.
