CSC Meeting February 8th Summary by Deb Herrick (DSC Rep)

- CSC minutes accepted
- Bulk tickets report
- Snow Ball News by Adela
 - > Actual Profit was about \$523 less than originally projected
 - Snow Ball 2017 will again be at the Hartford-Windsor Marriott \$500 deposit has been paid
 - Adela negotiated the minimum required expenditures with the new management. These include bar tab and appetizers in the main ballroom. She will go over in more detail at next meeting
 - Room Price Rate the same as last year but if you book online and get a different rate just mention you are with CSC so they include it in the total number of booked rooms
 - > Cancellation of room is now 24 hours prior instead of 6pm day of event
 - ▶ Date of Snow Ball is November 12th, 2017
- Kid's Day was a success at Mt. Southington and would like to have it there again next year, cost less, close by and more involvement; oh yeah and great pizza!
- On Snow-Winter Carnival
 - Can NOT use vouchers
 - > Ticket pricing on CSC website and in our newsletter, need your CSC sticker card
