A Special thanks to Burke Mountain for donating a two day/two night ski and stay package for our dinner dance. A GREAT place to ski!






LIVE ENTERTAINMENT

- Google Forms cannot do math, Use the Excel WORKSHEET on our website, to help you.
 - The Google Form is the OFFICIAL order form. It has checkboxes stating you are a member for the 2017/2018 season AND that you agree to abide by all the rules and be courteous to all mountain employees. If you don't answer YES to both questions, you will NOT be able to submit the form.
 - I NEED to receive all checks in the mail by Sept 27th, or delivered to me on Sept 28th (evening) at Chili's off I84 Exit 8 in Danbury between 6:30 and 8:30.
 - Once you complete your Google Form, I'll get back to you in a few days with the amount you owe.
 - Bank or Certified check to DSC is required if your order is over \$500.

 - Pick up vouchers at Hatters Park 12/7, 12/14 (Christmas Party), Ski Swap or Snowball, might be ready for 11/16 at Ski Haus.

Connecticut Ski Council 2017-2018 Bulk Ticket Policies, including OKEMO and DSC

09/08/2017 DZ

The following is the policy of the Connecticut Ski Council regarding the purchase and use of bulk ticket vouchers. The CSC requires that all member-clubs comply with these policies.

Be respectful to ALL mountain personnel. They are enforcing the rules as they know them.

Purchase of Vouchers:

Bulk tickets are for the exclusive use of dues-paying members of CSC member-clubs.

Exchange of Vouchers for Daily Lift Tickets:

- Each club member 18 years of age or older must be issued a club membership card, and the current year's CSC sticker must be affixed to that card. Family membership cards must list the names of family members on the card and must affix a current and valid CSC sticker for each person listed. Clubs may elect to issue membership cards to individuals under the age of 18 in lieu of listing names on a family card.
- EVERY PERSON WHO EXPECTS TO EXCHANGE A BULK TICKET VOUCHER FOR A DAY'S LIFT TICKET AT ANY MOUNTAIN RESORT MUST HAVE EITHER HIS/HER OWN INDIVIDUAL CLUB MEMBERSHIP CARD, OR BE INDIVIDUALLY NAMED ON THE FAMILY'S MEMBERSHIP CARD AND A VALID CSC STICKER AFFIXED FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL WHETHER ON HIS/HER OWN CARD OR ON A FAMILY CARD.
- Club membership cards will be shown by individuals to ticket window personnel when a voucher is being redeemed for a lift ticket. Mountain resorts have the right to request / require identification in addition to club membership cards at their discretion. Resorts also have the right to refuse redemption of voucher if a valid membership card is not presented for each voucher.

Policy Violations:

- Distribution of vouchers through other avenues such as but not limited to websites, eBay, resort parking lots, guests of rental properties or contest give-a-ways will result in banning of the individual from purchasing vouchers in the future.
- Names of chronic and blatant individual violators will be provided to all CSC member-clubs on an annual basis.
- Violation of the CT Ski Council policies will result in possible termination of the individual's membership in his/her club, and possible expulsion of the club from the CSC.
- Voucher can only be sold to other Danbury Ski Club/Ct Ski Council members. Record the serial number(s) of the vouchers and the name, address, email, phone number, Club name and CSC ID Number.
- Are you trying to buy or sell vouchers? Place an ad on the clubs bulletin board.
- Dave Zuraw, <u>dscwebmaster@yahoo.com</u>, or <u>vouchers@danburyski.com</u> (checked occasionally throughout the season).

Return of Unused Vouchers at Close of Season:

- Try to use your vouchers in order (it helps the return process).
- All unused vouchers shall be returned to Danbury Ski Club no later than the 3rd Thursday of April no exceptions.
- Return all unused vouchers in the envelop they came in, marked with the quantity returned for each voucher type.
- Credit percentage will be determined by CSC based on credit provided by each mountain, which shall be applied to the purchase of the following year's vouchers.
- The percentage will vary according to the contract with the individual participating resort.

Okemo Bulk Ticket Program 2017-2018

- Okemo tickets cannot be used at Mt. Sunapee.
- Carry ONLY ONE TICKET with you when you ski. All tickets you carry will be scanned & will be INVALID when you try them.
- In addition, no other RFID cards from other resorts may be carried concurrently.
- All skiers will be scanned at lift entry, and skier ID and photo stored in the scanner.
- At the end of the ski day, TEAR UP AND THROW OUT THE USED TICKET. They may NOT be reloaded.
- Okemo will continue to accept a 20% return at the end of the season.
- Okemo will deduct \$1 for every ticket returned from the credit due for the next ski season.
- We know every bulk ticket serial number and who it was issued to.
- Credits from the return of last season's vouchers will be applied to the purchase of this season's tickets, as always.

I tried a USB2.0 hub in line, problem solved!
