Destination: Jungfrau Region - Interlaken, Switzerland

Grindelwald, Switzerland offers something for everyone. The greater Jungfrau region is an area for visitors who never get enough of spectacular scenery. Follow the sun as it passes over the 13,026 ft. Eiger--Take a train to the highest station in Europe--the 11,333 foot Jungfraujoch and enjoy the incredible panorama--Oh yeah, and the skiing is pretty darn good too! With over 45 lifts and 4550 ft of vertical, you'll be sure to wear yourself thin! Ski direct from lifts in the center of town to the nearby areas of Wengen and Murren and be sure to make a stop for lunch at one of the Jungfrau region's famous slope-side restaurants—the Famous Piz Gloria maybe? Grüezi!

The three regions Grindelwald-First, Kleine Scheidegg-Männlichen and Mürren-Schilthorn together offer a total of 213 km of ski runs ranging from fast to leisurely, and from six to twelve kilometres in length. A total of more than 40 percent of the ski runs are equipped with snow-making machines. In the Jungfrau Region however, non-skiers also get their money's worth: 100 kilometres of winter footpaths enable you to explore the mountains on foot. Furthermore, with its countless toboggan runs, the region is a real paradise for tobogganing. Amongst them is the longest toboggan run in the Alps.

After skiing, spend your time wandering through town shopping or people watching in one of Grindelwald's cozy pubs and cafes. Dancing more your thing? You don't have to go far to party in Grindelwald—if you still have the energy left!

The cozy 3 star **Hotel Central Wolter** is conveniently located in Grindelwald, just one minute's walk from the train station and from all bus services to the Jungfrau, Männlichen and First region. Enjoy regional and international cuisine in the hotel Wolter's restaurant with its heated outdoor terrace, which is an inviting place also on colder days. The breakfast and dining room for guests having booked half board is located on the second floor, from where you have superb views of the Eiger. The cozy lounge is a great place for nice chats with fellow travelers.
