DSC / CSC Bulk Ticket Policies and Instructions for 2018/2019

09/20/2018 DZ

The following is the policy of the Connecticut Ski Council regarding the purchase and use of bulk ticket vouchers. The CSC requires that all member-clubs comply with these policies.

Be respectful to ALL mountain personnel. They are enforcing the rules as they know them.

Purchase of Vouchers:

- Bulk tickets are for the exclusive use of dues-paying members of CSC member-clubs and may NOT be used by, or sold to anyone else.
 - For Mount Snow: You MUST use your full credit and ONLY your credit, plus \$2 per return to cover cost increase. Additional vouchers can be purchased another way. Details below.
- You may give/sell/transfer/donate your credit to someone else if you choose. This is recommended for those that have been carrying credit for several years and most likely will not use it.
- We received FULL CREDIT from all mountains except Killington: 57%.
- Most prices for 2018/2019 are below. Others will be updated on our website, including the Google Form and Excel sheet when received.
- Stowe is no longer participating in the voucher program.
- We've had no Sunapee orders the last few years, so I removed them as well.

Exchange of Vouchers for Daily Lift Tickets:

- Each club member must have a current Danbury Ski Club membership card with a current CSC sticker affixed.
- Mountains may request/require identification in addition to club membership cards at their discretion.
- Mountains may refuse redemption of voucher if a valid membership card is not presented for each voucher.
- NEVER have more than ONE RFID lift ticket on you at any time. If they are for the same mountain, they will both be void after that day. If a different mountain, the scanners may reject you.

Policy Violations:

- Distribution of vouchers through other avenues such as, but not limited to, websites, eBay, resort parking lots, guests of rental properties or contest give-a-ways will result in banning of the individual from purchasing vouchers in the future.
- Names of chronic and blatant individual violators will be provided to all CSC member-clubs on an annual basis.
- Violation of the CT Ski Council policies will result in possible termination of the individual's membership in his/her club, and possible expulsion of the club from the CSC.
- Voucher can only be used by other Danbury Ski Club or Ct Ski Council club members.
- Are you trying to buy or sell vouchers? Place an ad on the club's bulletin board.

Return of Unused Vouchers at Close of Season:

- All unused vouchers shall be returned to Danbury Ski Club no later than the 3rd Thursday of April.
 - Mount Snow will no longer accept returns!
- Do NOT return used vouchers. Be especially careful with used RFID vouchers, mark, bend or destroy after use.
- Return all unused vouchers in the envelope provided, marked with the quantity returned for each voucher type.
- Credit percentage will be determined by CSC based on credit allowed by each mountain, which shall be applied to the purchase of the following year's vouchers.
- The percentage will vary according to the contract with the individual participating resort.
- We know every bulk ticket serial number and who it was issued to. If you sell or give a voucher to someone else, record the serial number and who it was given to, with contact info and an acknowledgement from them. If not, you are responsible for the person using that voucher.

Okemo Details

- **All skiers will be scanned at lift entry, and skier ID and photo stored in the scanner.**
- At the end of the ski day, TEAR UP AND THROW OUT THE USED TICKET.
 - They may NOT be reloaded.
 - Note: Your CSC Awareness Day RFID lift ticket IS RELOADABLE, so don't mix them up!
- Okemo will continue to accept a 20% return at the end of the season.
- Okemo will deduct \$1 for every ticket returned from the credit due for the next ski season.
- Credits from the return of last season's vouchers will be applied to the purchase of this season's tickets.

Killington/Pico Details

- The first-time a member uses a voucher, they **must purchase a reloadable One Pass Card (RFID) at a ticket window for \$5.** If you lose or forget this card, you will have to purchase another.
- Present your RFID card, voucher, valid Club membership card and your photo ID to have the RFID card loaded for a day of skiing.
- Place your RFID card in a ski jacket pocket and it will be scanned at the lift for a day of skiing / boarding. Keep this away from any electronic devices or electro-magnetic fields.
- Keep the One Pass Card for use next season.
- Killington has not specified if this reloadable card can be used for Awareness days, but I hope it will be.
- Killington allowed ONLY 10% last season!

Sugarbush Details

- The first-time a member uses a voucher, they **must purchase a reloadable Sugarbush Xpress Card (RFID) at the ticket window for \$5.** If you lose or forget this card, you must purchase another.
- Present this card, your voucher, your valid Club membership card and your photo ID to have this RFID card loaded for a day of skiing.
- Place your RFID card in a ski jacket pocket and it will be scanned at the lift for a day of skiing / boarding. Keep this away from any electronic devices or electro-magnetic fields.
- The Sugarbush Xpress Card may be presented at a ticket window on Awareness Days to purchase ticket and validation (loading) of the RFID card for a day of skiing/boarding. Present your club membership card with the CSC member sticker and photo ID at the time of purchase.
- Keep the Sugarbush Xpress card. It might be usable next season (TBD).

MOUNT SNOW DETAILS (BIG CHANGES)

- NEW lift tickets will be purchased by individuals on-line through the Mount Snow website. See below.
- **The ONLY tickets purchased using the "old" method will be to use the credit from last season.**
- Individuals must pay \$2 per return due to the increase in ticket pricing from last season to this coming season.
- **There will be NO CREDIT next year no matter how they were purchased.**
- Bulk tickets **cannot** be used at Winter Carnival. Special prices will be in effect for that weekend.
- Mount Snow will offer the Everyday Benefit Online Program again this season. See their website for details.

MOUNT SNOW: Purchase Lift Tickets Using the New Method (not using last year's credit)

MOUNT SNOW: How to Purchase:

- Go to mountsnow.com/csc
- Use your club specific log in and password to see the products available and select bulk ticket.
Mount Snow has NOT assigned these login's yet!!!
- Enter quantity (Suggest you buy for each visit. The price does not change all season.)
- Add to Cart>Proceed to Checkout>Log In or check out as a guest
- Your credit card will be charged when you check-out online, not with the staff at the ticket window.
- Please note that online bulk tickets **cannot** be returned or exchanged.

MOUNT SNOW: What Comes Next:

- You will receive two emails per transaction, regardless of the number of tickets you purchase in one transaction:
- A thank-you email confirming your purchase, and
- An email that includes a link to a web page that displays barcodes.
 - Click on the link in the 2nd email. It will take you to a page with barcodes. Each unique barcode represents a lift ticket you purchased. The barcode(s) must be scanned at the ticket window to redeem your lift ticket.
 - There are two ways to present the barcode at the ticket window:
 - Print the page before you come to the mountain and bring the print-out with you, or
 - Have the page open on your mobile device.
- Once a barcode is scanned, it cannot be used again.

MOUNT SNOW: Perks:

- Individuals purchase online bulk tickets directly from Mount Snow.
- They are NOT Date Specific and there are No blackout dates.
- Purchase any time during the 2018-19 season for the same price, including SAME DAY.
- Redeem at any ticket window.
- No limitations on the number of bulk tickets you can purchase.

MOUNT SNOW: Important Details:

- No returns on paper bulk tickets or online bulk tickets.
- Must show your club card and current CSC sticker and photo ID at the time you redeem.
- Cannot be replaced if lost or stolen.
- If you purchase more than one bulk ticket at a time please keep the confirmation information in your email.

MOUNT SNOW: How To:

- Price: \$68 all season long
- To purchase, go to www.mountsnow.com/csc
- Account Name: MSCSC(Club Specific)* Password: XXXX
- Program dates: purchase as many times as you want for the 2018 – 2019 season
- Print your email confirmation including the barcodes or show your barcodes to any Mount Snow ticket seller to redeem for lift tickets. Tickets valid for 2018 - 2019 season only.
- MUST BRING CT SKI CLUB CARD WITH CURRENT STICKER AND PHOTO ID at the time of redemption.
- *Each club will receive a specific account name which will be assigned by Mount Snow.

HOW TO ORDER VOUCHERS for the 2018-2019 SEASON

WITH DANBURY SKI CLUB

- All the files and links about vouchers will be on the Vouchers page of our website during the week of Sept. 17th!
- Sugarbush price added 9/20, Waterville not available yet. I'll update Google Form & worksheet when available.
- Use this link to complete your order in Google Form. Just right click on it and select "Open HyperLink"

- Google Forms cannot do math, use the Excel WORKSHEET on our website, to help you calculate what you owe.
- The Google Form is the OFFICIAL order form. It has checkboxes indicating you are a member for the 2018/2019 season AND that you agree to abide by all the rules and be courteous to all mountain employees. If you don't answer YES to both questions, you will NOT be able to submit the form.
- I am sorry, but you will have to enter a "0" for each voucher type you do NOT want to purchase.
- There is a \$3 "donation" for each order to cover administrative costs (envelops, labels, ink, etc.).
- Include the refund amount that was emailed to you earlier.
- If the amount you owe is incorrect as entered in the Google Form, I will let you know several days later.
- All checks MUST be received by me by **Sept 27th Oct 2nd** (since mountains were so late getting usd the information) mail to: Dave Zuraw, 33 Hilltop Road, Naugatuck, CT 06770, or delivered to me on Sept 27th (evening) at Chili's off I84 Exit 8 in Danbury between 7:00 and 8:00pm. I will also accept orders and checks at our Sept. 20th meeting and our Picnic Sept 22nd.
- Bank or Certified check to DSC is required for orders \$500 and over.
- If vouchers are received from Ct Ski Council when planned, they will be **available for pick-up on:** Nov 17th (Snowball), Nov 23, 24, 25, Dec 1, 2: (SkiSwap), Dec 6th (DSC Meeting) and Dec 13 (Christmas Party).
- If you cannot pickup vouchers at any of the listed dates, contact Dave Zuraw to coordinate pickup.
- If you intend for a friend to pick them up, let me know who and when, via email, the subject being:
 Vouchers: Friend Pickup for "your name" by "friends name"
- If you can't arrange for pickup, please mail me a **PRE-PAID, SELF ADDRESSED LABEL for FEDEX or UPS** between Nov 5th and 21st (not before, not after). I will only visit UPS and FEDEX ONCE in Early December. Use the least expensive method you can, as long as it includes TRACKING and you can provide the label (NOT AN ENVELOPE)! Emailing me a label file that I can print out and insert in a pocket in the envelope is also acceptable.
- **Danbury Ski Club, Ct Ski Council and the mountains are NOT responsible if they get lost in the mail!**

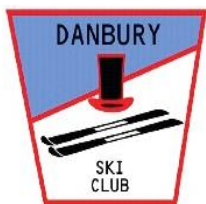

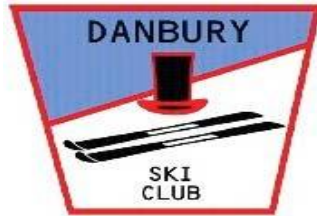
