Starting the Monday, Dec 17 Monday Night Racing starts with registration and a pizza night at Mt Southington from 7-9pm.


Skiing is available as the mountain is open but we will not be racing this Monday. See www.danburyski.com for a draft schedule for racing. We will update as we know more.

DSC / CSC Bulk Ticket Policies and Instructions for 2018/2019

MOUNT SNOW vouchers

- There will be NO CREDIT next year no matter how the vouchers are purchased.
- Bulk tickets cannot be used at Winter Carnival.
- Go to mountsnow.com/csc and login using Danbury's club specific log in and password:

Account Name: MSCSC-106
Password: mountsnow

- Enter quantity (for visit, could be same day), add to cart and proceed to checkout. They aren't date specific.
- Your credit card will be charged when you check-out online. No returns or exchanges.
- You will receive a thank-you email confirming your purchase, -AND- an email with a link to a barcode page.
- <u>Click on the link</u> to see a barcode for each lift ticket you purchased which will be scanned at ANY ticket window to redeem your lift ticket (from paper or your mobile device).
- Once scanned, a barcode cannot be used again. Cannot be replaced if lost or stolen.
- Must show your club card and current CSC sticker and photo ID at the time you redeem.
- Keep the confirmation and barcode emails for each purchase.
- Mount Snow will offer the Everyday Benefit Online Program again this season. See their website for details.

East Coast Greenway: an organization DSC supports

An organization connecting people to place from Maine to Florida, https://www.greenway.org
It's the nation's longest connected biking and walking route. Imagine a place where bicyclists, walkers, runners, inline skaters, horseback riders, wheelchair users, cross-country skiers and more — of all ages and abilities — feel safe, for commuting and recreation. And while out for a day's ride, you may pass people traveling from state to state — or the entire East Coast.

This fall, ECG had an article on a portion of the Greenway in our area "The Bronx". Thousands of cyclists are already using existing trails in The Bronx which comprising of The Bronx River Greenway, Pelham and Mosholu Parkways Greenway, Shore Road Greenway, through Van Cortlandt Park and many other local greenways. These Bronx greenways and trails contribute over 13 miles to the East Coast Greenway. You can even see ECG markers along these points in The Bronx.

Besides the 3,000 miles of the main greenway, there are approximately 1,000 miles of "complimentary routes and spurs including one that takes you down The Bronx River greenway from the river's source in Westchester and down through the South Bronx.
